

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Shower enclosures should be cleaned after every use. To prevent limescale from building up, use a squeegee, a soft cloth or chamois leather-but no cleaning-to wipe off any water droplets left after showering. Residue left by bodycare products (liquid soap, shampoo, shower gel) can also cause substances to accumulate. Use water to rinse away residues after use. All sliding door track fittings should also be cleaned this way-to ensure that they continue run smoothly.

- Don't allow limescale to build up-especially in hard water areas
- If you do get a stubborn limescale build up,a mixture of 50:50 vinegar and water will help you to clean it away-but make sure all vinegar is rinsed off completely Never use strong detergents or cleaning agents

 Cleaning materials should wherever possible be rated between PH4 and PH8

 In no circumstances should you use any abrasive substance



5. FM Digital Radio


- 5.1 FM Radio: The frequency range is 87-108MHz.
- 5.2 When system is on, touch "button to open the radio, the speaker makes a sound and the sign of "FM" and current frequency display on the LCD. Touch
- "button again to close the radio, the corresponding sign disappears."
- 5.3When radio is on, touch" "button, the current radio frequency increased by 100KHz; if touching this button over 1 second, the system searches the FM channels automatically and DPLL auto locks the channels, LCD displays the radio frequency.

When frequency up to 108.0 MHz, touch" "button, the frequency jumps down to 87.5 MHz.

- 5.5 When the radio is on, touch "button to adjust the volume, the sign of "VOL" and current volume flash on the LCD, then touch "or "or "button to increase or decrease the volume, the range is 0-10.
- 5.6 Store channels and read channels.
- 5.6.1 Store channels: When the channel needed to store is chosen, touch "button for 2 seconds, the "CH" sign and the storage position are displayed on the LCD, short touch on" "button to choose the storage position(0-18 position), then press "button for 2 seconds to store the current channel to the storage position, LCD backs to display the current frequency.
- 5.6.2 Read channels: When radio is on, short press on "button to read the channels,
- LCD displays the "CH" sign and the storage position, 1 second later, LCD backs to display the current frequency. User can repeat above operations to read the channels which are stored in 0-18 positions.

2, Keyboard Diagram and Operations:





Keyboard contains 8 buttons, functions are as follows:

Light button Fan button

Store Channel button

Parameter adjust button

Parameter adjust button

Volume button Radio button

Power On/off

3. Operation Instruction:

1. Lock:

When system is on, without any operation in 3 minutes, the keyboard will be locked automatically and the corresponding sign flashes on LED. Press any button for 3 seconds to unlock the keyboard, and the sign disappears.

2. Power On/Off:

When power on, touch "O" button to start the system, ceiling light is on.


Touch "O" button again, the system is off, together with other functions.


3, Fan Function:

When system is on, touch " button to start the fan, the fan sign flashes on the LCD; Touch " button again to turn off the fan, and the fan sign disappears.

4. Light Function:

When system is on, the ceiling light is on; touch "button to turn off the ceiling light, touch again to turn on it. When light is on, the corresponding light sign flashes on the LCD.








1. Connection Diagram
